Wi-Fi and Power @ RA

- ▷ Free wireless access is available in most areas of the convention center, including the lobby, Delegate Café, and RA Hall.
- ▷ A very limited number of free charging stations for personal computing devices are available in the lobby areas.
- ▷ Delegates using laptops, netbooks, smart phones, and other devices while at the convention center should fully charge batteries prior to arriving, and carry back-up batteries if they are available.
- ▷ Delegates are encouraged to download convention-related materials prior to coming to Chicago. If you must download items after arrival, you are encouraged to download from your hotel before arriving at the convention center.
- ▷ Please be courteous to your fellow delegates while on the convention center's wireless network by avoiding high-bandwidth data such as streaming music, video, or other large file downloads.
