

STANDING UP FOR SAFE SCHOOLS

FOR OUR STUDENTS AND SCHOOL EMPLOYEES

- During the COVID crisis, TSTA and our local associations have been standing up for safety and equity
- From CDC guidelines, we created the definitive Standards for Safe Schools at the beginning of the pandemic
- *Is this safe?* survey gathered over 1,100 responses from employees in over 150 districts and identified over 6,000 different health and safety violations
- Fought for, and won, the prioritization of school employees for the vaccine
- Statewide safety campaigns gathered over 15,000 signatures on petitions and letters to state government demanding school safety, safe reopening, and vaccines for educators
- Locals across the state mobilized hundreds of employees for rallies and actions demanding corrections to safety violations
- Filed, and won, local grievances across Texas demanding an end to violations of health and safety standards
- Fought for safe reopening and continued virtual learning where safety standards were not being met
- Standing for at-risk employees, demanding and winning accommodations
- Fighting for equity in resources and opportunities in our communities
- Leading the effort to make sure that federal rescue dollars for schools aren't diverted to balance the state budget

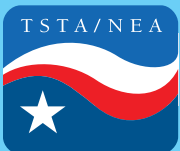


Starting April 1, you can join TSTA, and your local association, and pay NO DUES UNTIL FALL.
